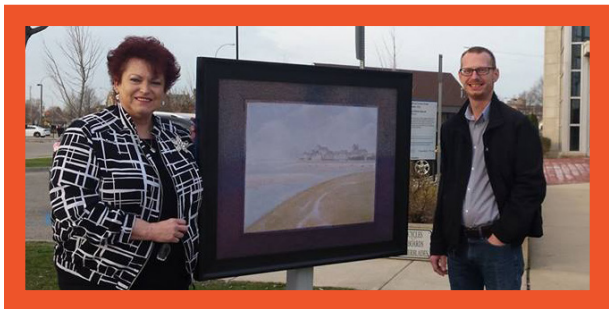

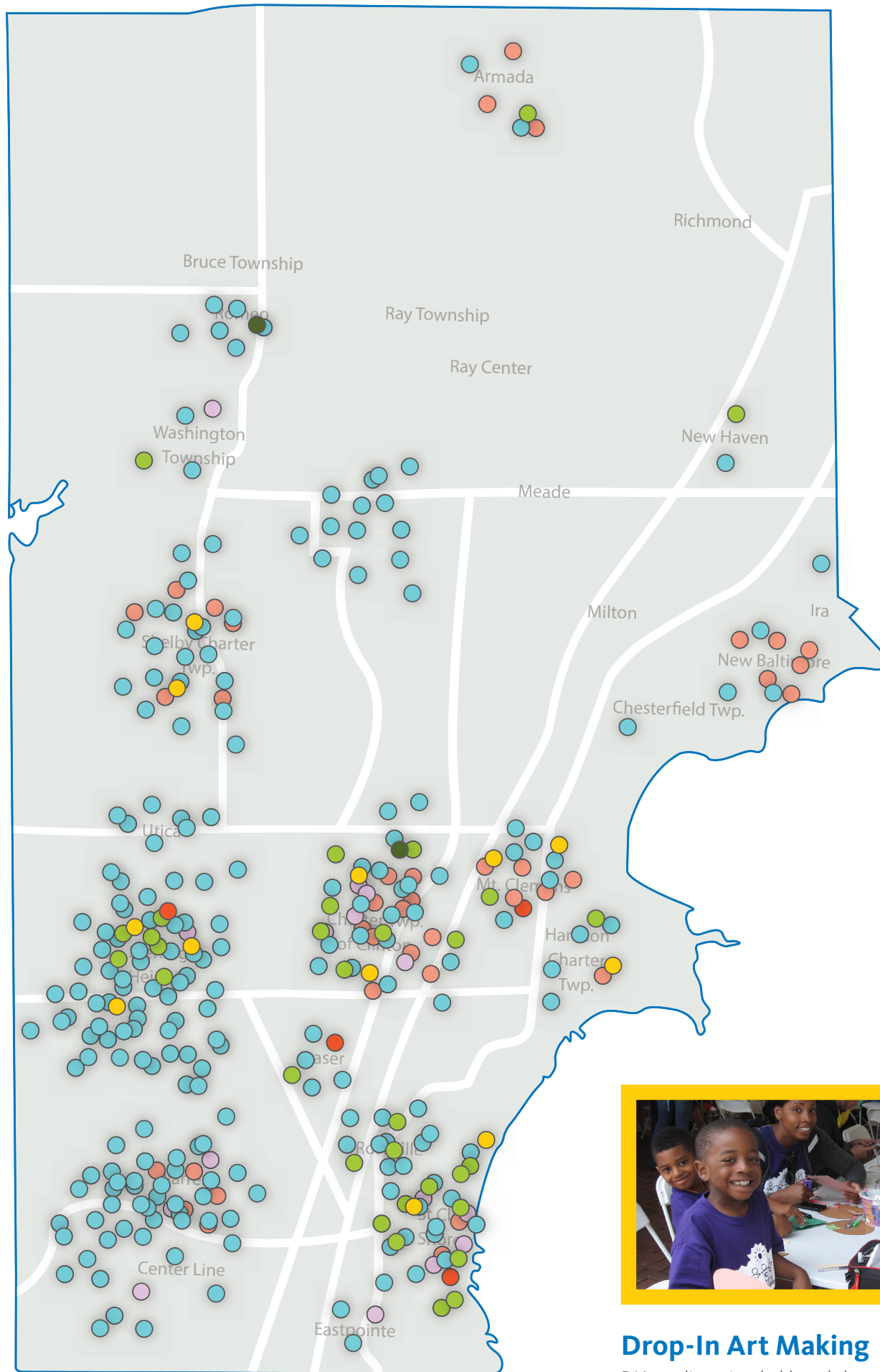
Inside|Out

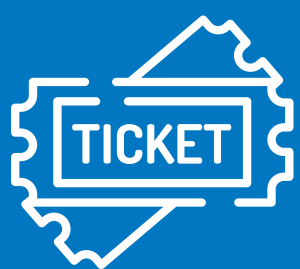
