



## DIA Film & Photography Policies

### Wedding and Engagement Photography

- Wedding and engagement photography is allowed for free outside the museum, as long as it doesn't disturb visitor access. Please be considerate of others.
- **No** wedding or engagement photography is permitted inside the building unless you rent the space. Please email [catering@dia.org](mailto:catering@dia.org) to reserve your location for photography.

### Personal Photography

- Selfies are encouraged! Feel free to share them on social media, but please don't disrupt other visitors.
- Flash photography is not allowed. No selfie sticks or tripods.
- Celebrations and impromptu gatherings can disrupt others and endanger artworks. These are not allowed.
- Some exhibitions may restrict personal photography. Please check before taking photos.

### Press, News, and Media Photo / Film Policy

- Media members must obtain permission from the Marketing & Communications Department before filming inside the DIA. Please email [pr@dia.org](mailto:pr@dia.org)
- All video and photography shoots need approval and scheduling in advance. Media may take exterior photos anytime.

### Student Film Shoots / Personal Projects

- Student films and/or personal projects are not allowed in the museum.
